

Avondale Sunday Markets Information

The following information is an in-depth guide for both sellers and visitors to the market.

Opening hours

The market is open **EVERY** Sunday (**Rain, Hail, or Public Holidays**)

It's open from 5 am to 12 lunch time

sellers or stall holders need to go early 7 am (minimum) if you want to get your cars or trucks in, or you may be turned away.

Public Car Parking

Public car parking is available from the main gate at a minimal cost of \$3 for the whole day

selling products or services at the markets?

Please read this part very carefully

You can sell almost anything at the markets, without any issues but the following part you need to understand no matter if you don't like what is said here.

There cannot be sold in the grounds of the market ANY FOOD products.

NO HOT FOOD OR LIVE FOOD

(This includes anything made and is sold ready to eat on the day like cakes and baking etc or hot made food and this rule will not be tolerated no matter what, as all food vendors on the grounds have a council food certificate and express permission from the market owner to be on site, also council food inspectors are regular visitors to the markets.

Please note that if you think you have a product that isn't on the market grounds or is better than something currently offered on the grounds we unfortunately don't want to get into a conversation over this as all food sites are fully booked already, we are sorry for this but we get many requests per week asking why they cannot have their food on the grounds)

Can I get money out or use Eftpos at the markets?

Yes money is available via cash out vendor on the site.

Casual Stall holders information

Please note the following if you are intending on having a stall at the markets

1. There is NO power available for any stall sites so bring your own inverter if this is a requirement
2. There is a single power point made available for sellers to test sold electrical devices by the door of the market office.
3. Tables are available if needed for your stall from \$10 dollars per day (see office for these on the day)
4. Stall sites cost \$20 per Sunday and will be collected by a market employee on the day
5. Please note if you are a casual stall holder you will be placed where ever there is available space so get there early if you want a reasonable site
6. You may sell directly from your car boot if you require or from tables on your allocated site.
7. If you have an issue with your site or a co sellers site please see the office.
8. At NO time are the Avondale Sunday Markets liable for any loss or damage that may happen on the grounds related to you, or your site, so lock up anything you don't want to lose.

Can I busk at the markets?

Normally if you want to busk at the markets you need to contact the market line and ask for permission, but as a general rule you can, but the markets management will not allow any amplified sound equipment or microphone's ECT as this cause nuisance to other stall holders and customers.

Also if Market staff ask you to move or quiet down you will adhere to this or you will be asked to leave sorry

Things to remember

If you are intending on coming to the markets we ask that you act sensibly and try to act with tolerance.

We try to provide a safe site to let you sell, buy, or just come to have fun, and if you have any issues with members of the public or the stalls note that we have security at the main gates and regular Police attendance on site.

So be safe and lock up and take care
